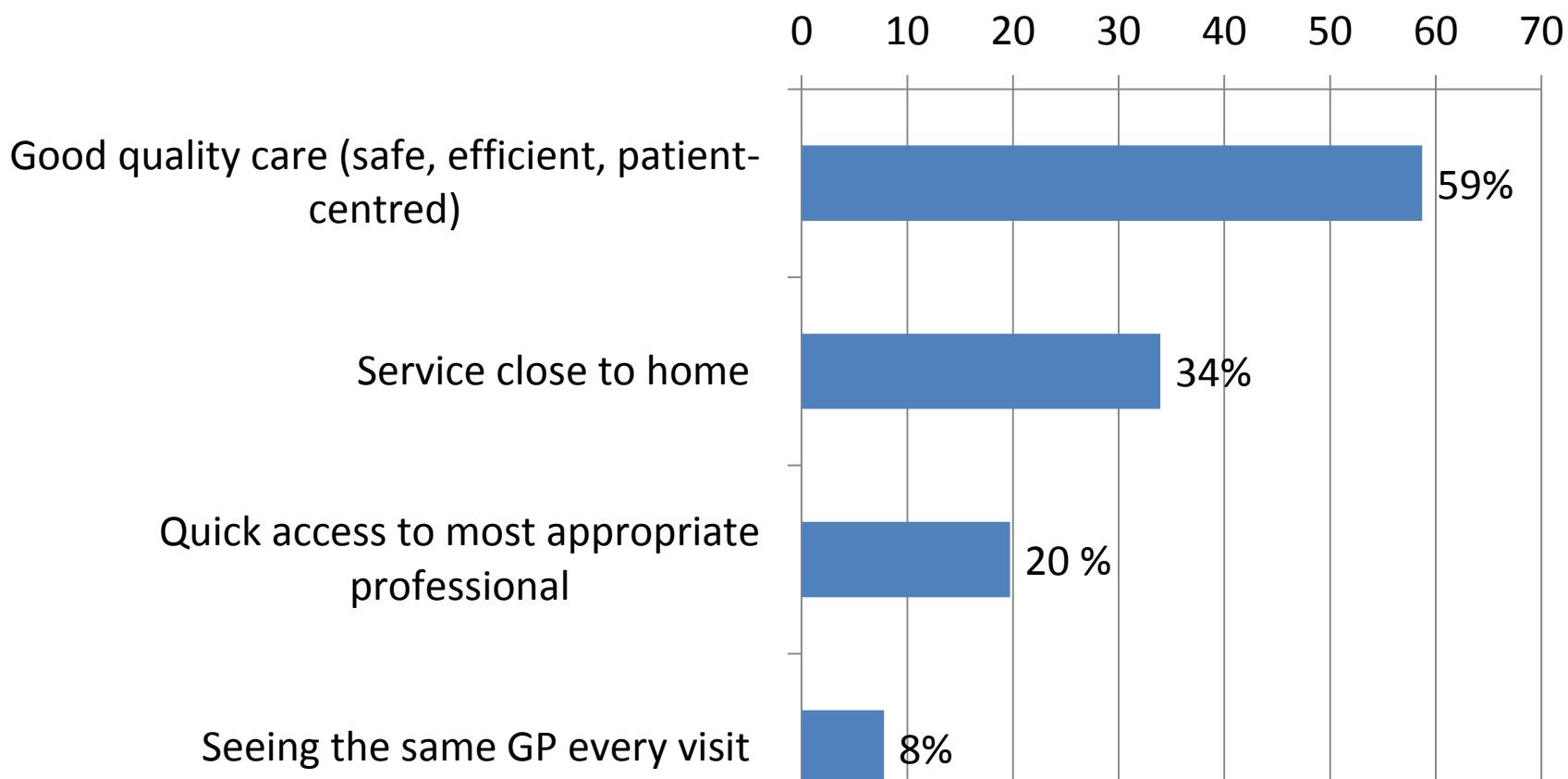


Responses

- 5% felt that the questionnaire and information was not understandable



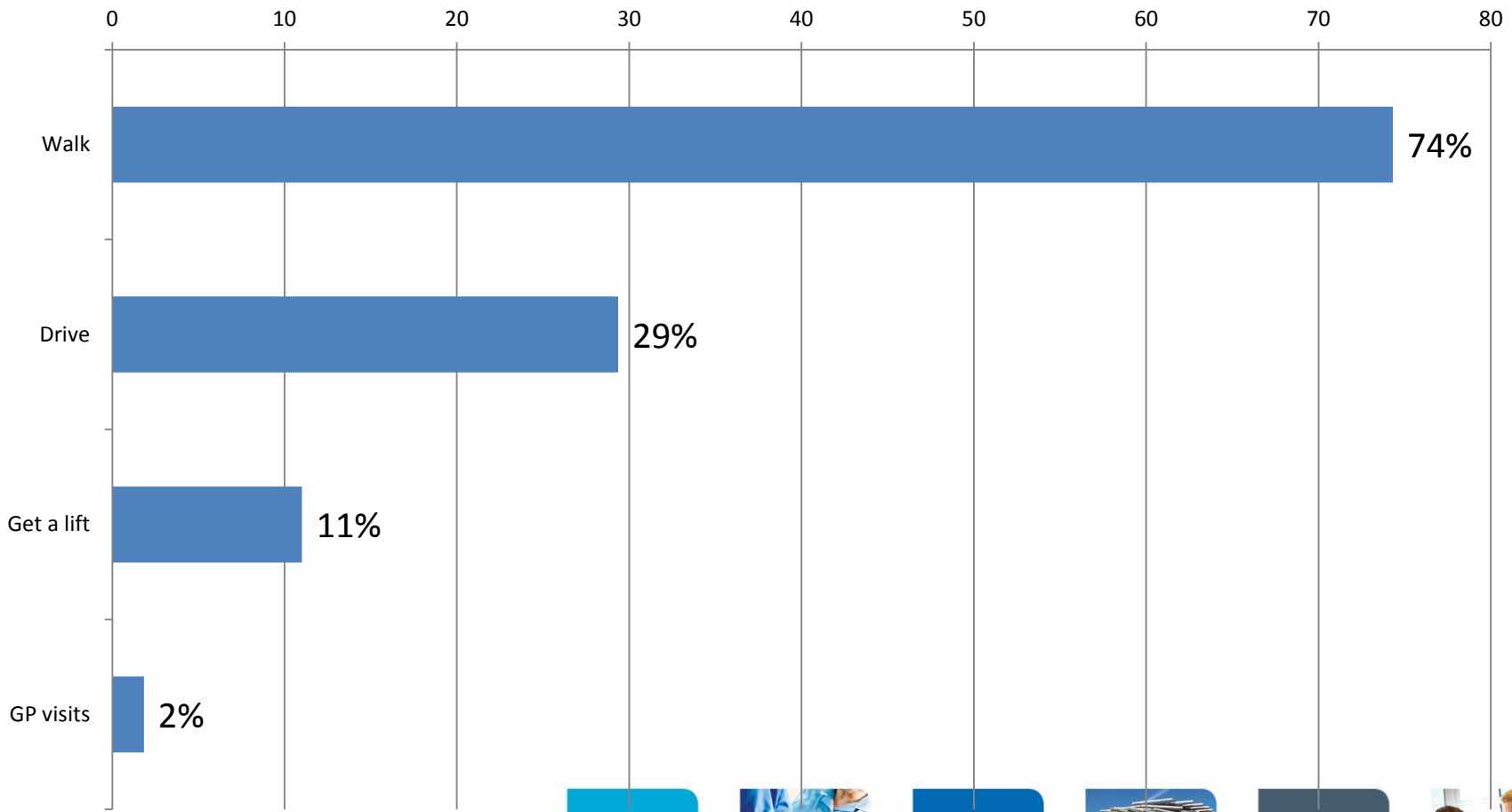

How do you normally get to the GP appointment ?



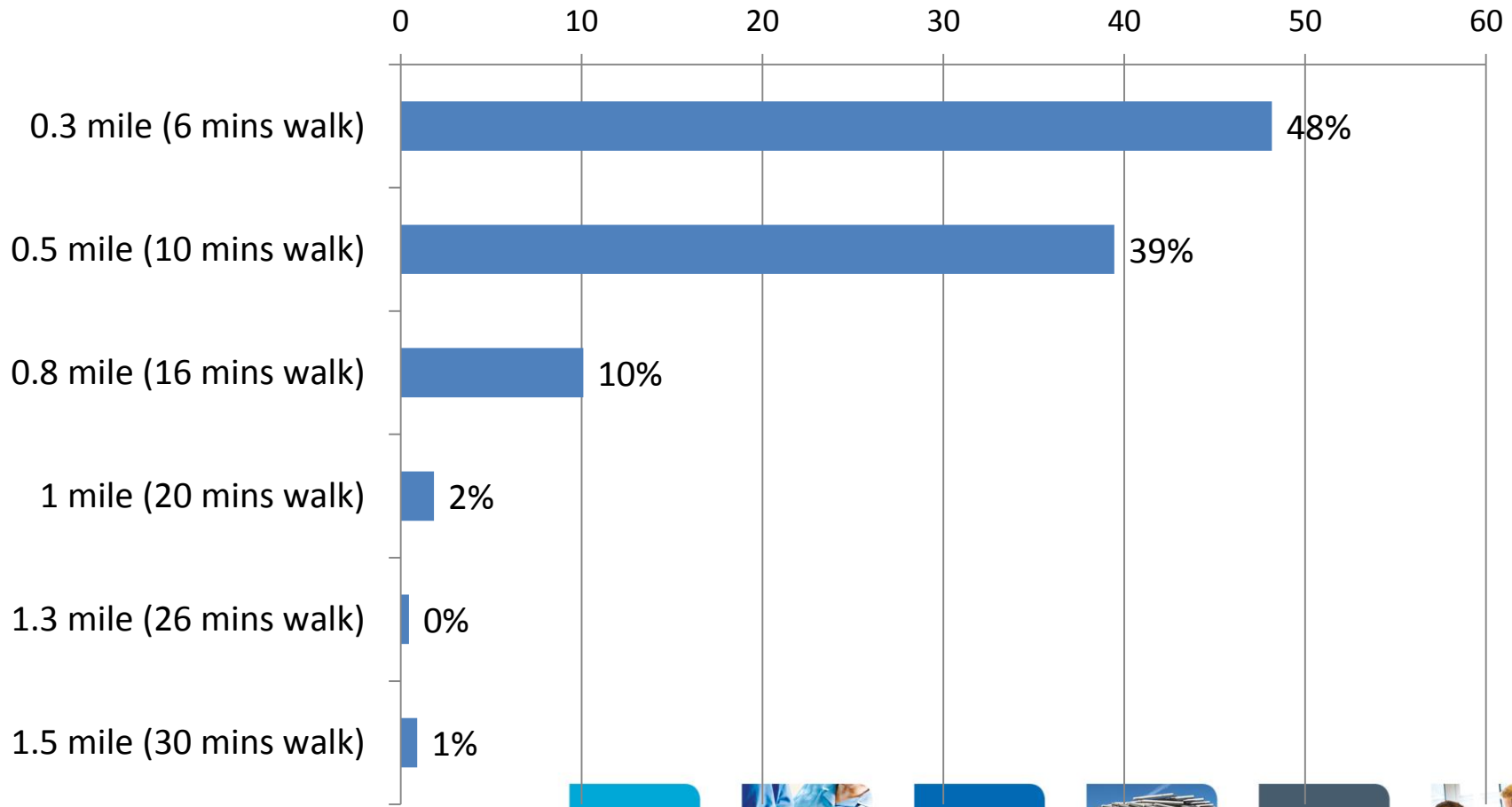

How far are you prepared to travel?



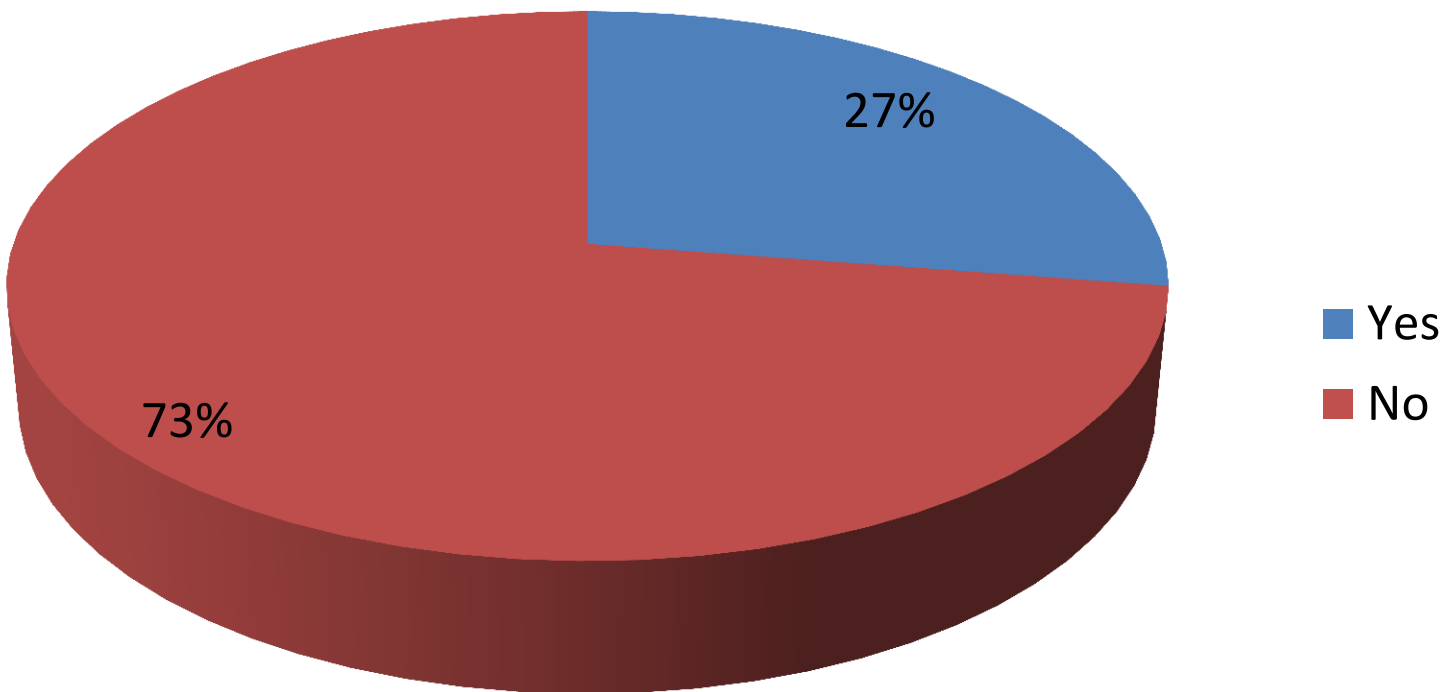

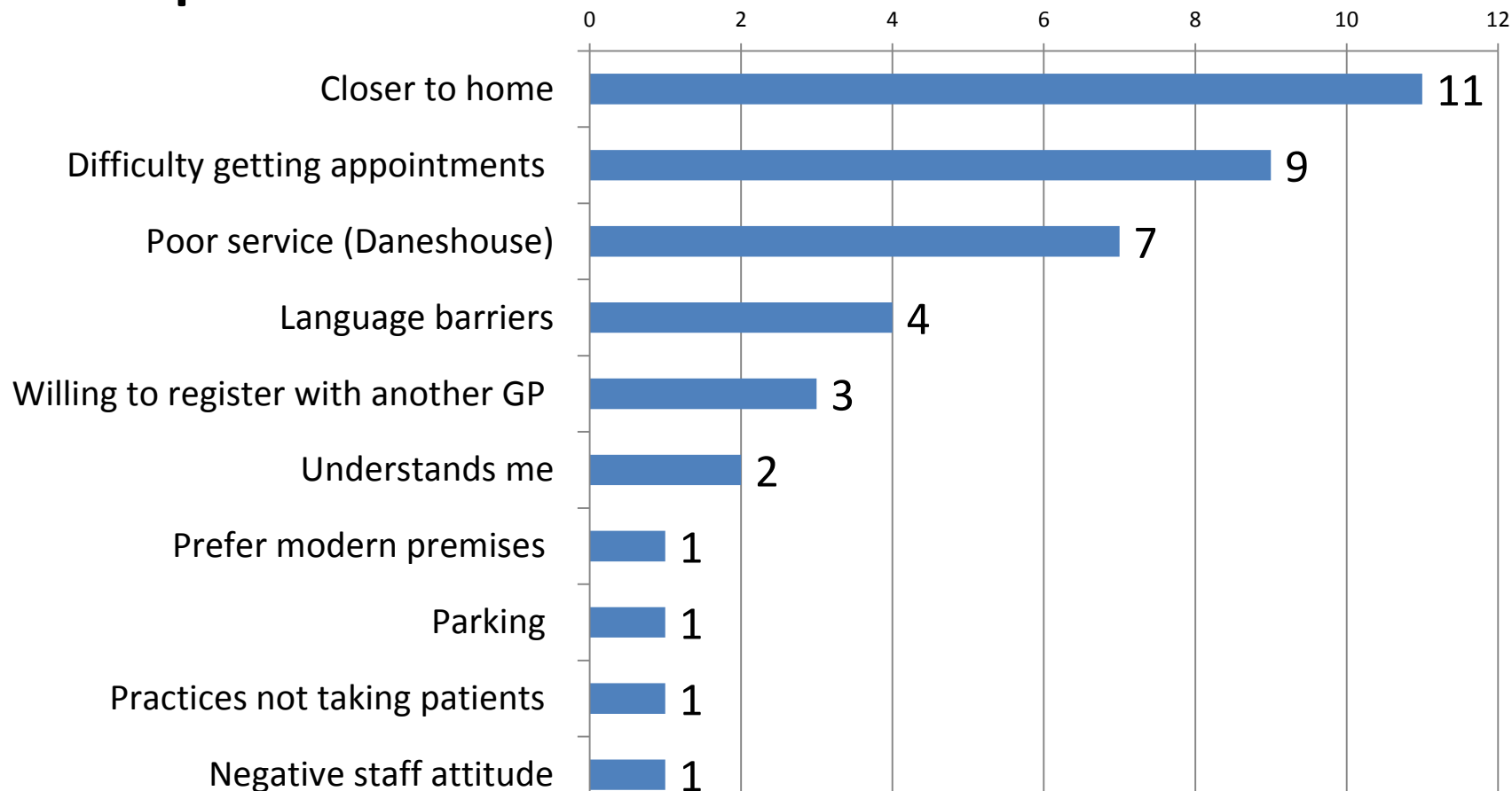
Would you register with any of the other 7 neighbouring GP practices if you could?

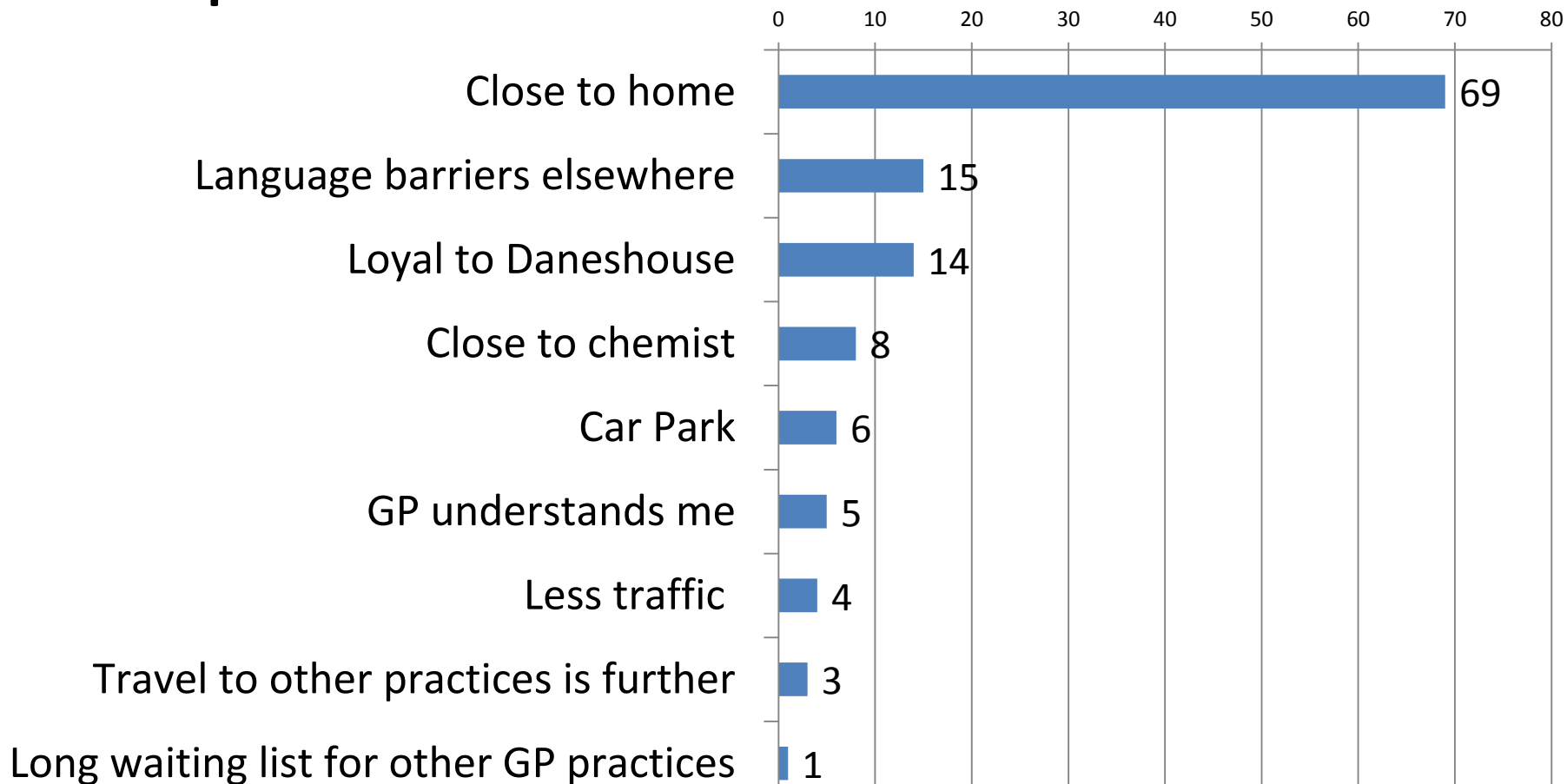
Why those who could register with other practices would?

Why those who could register with other practices would not?



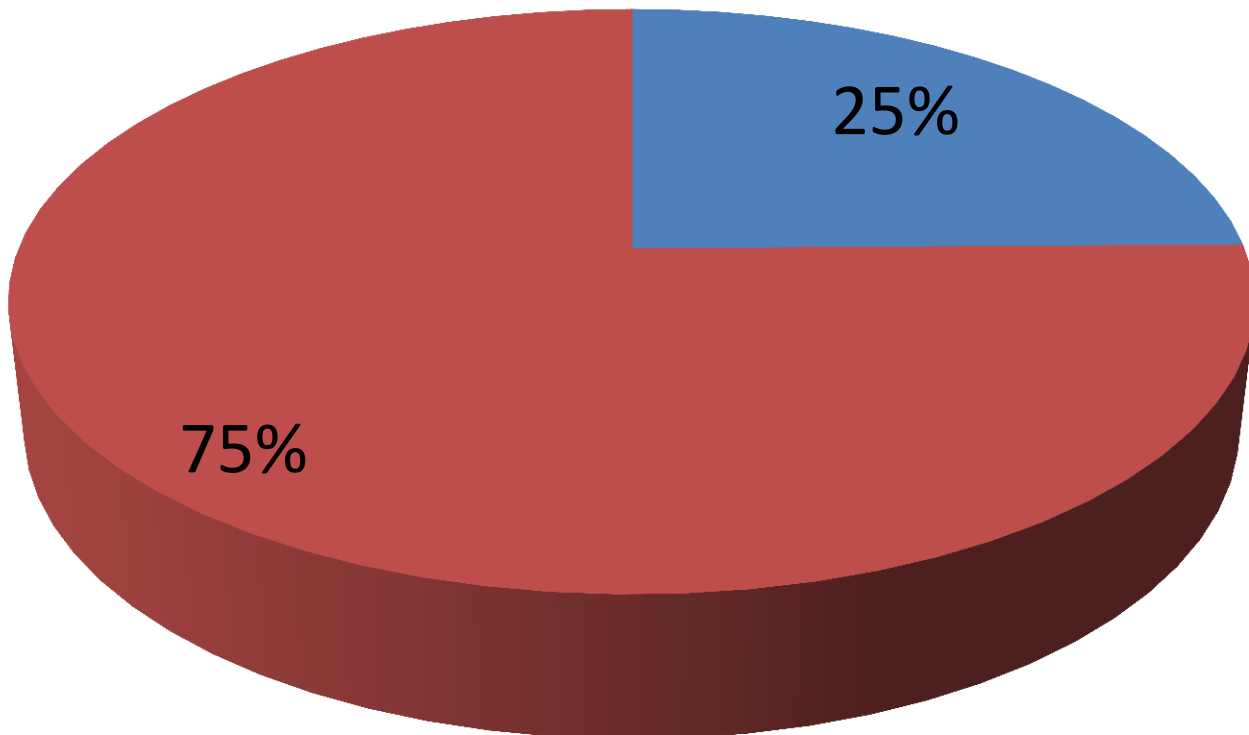

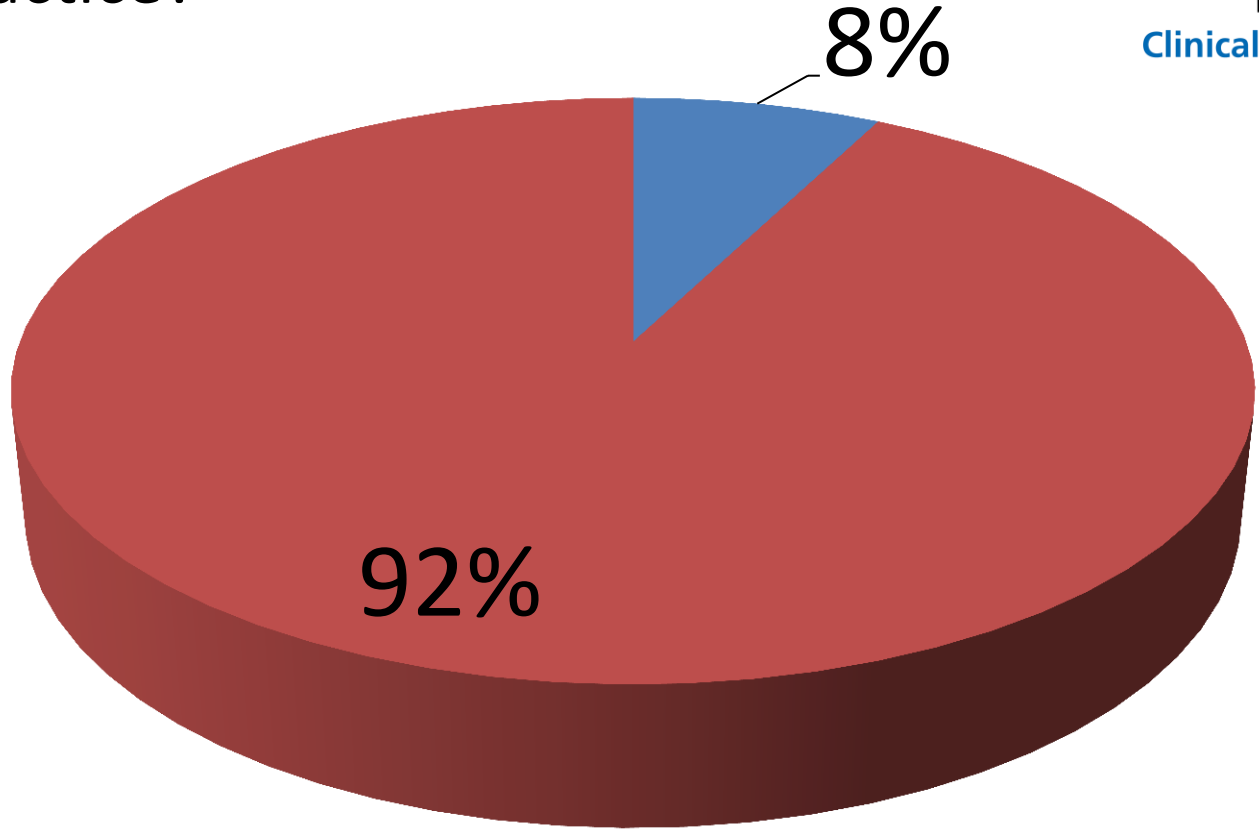

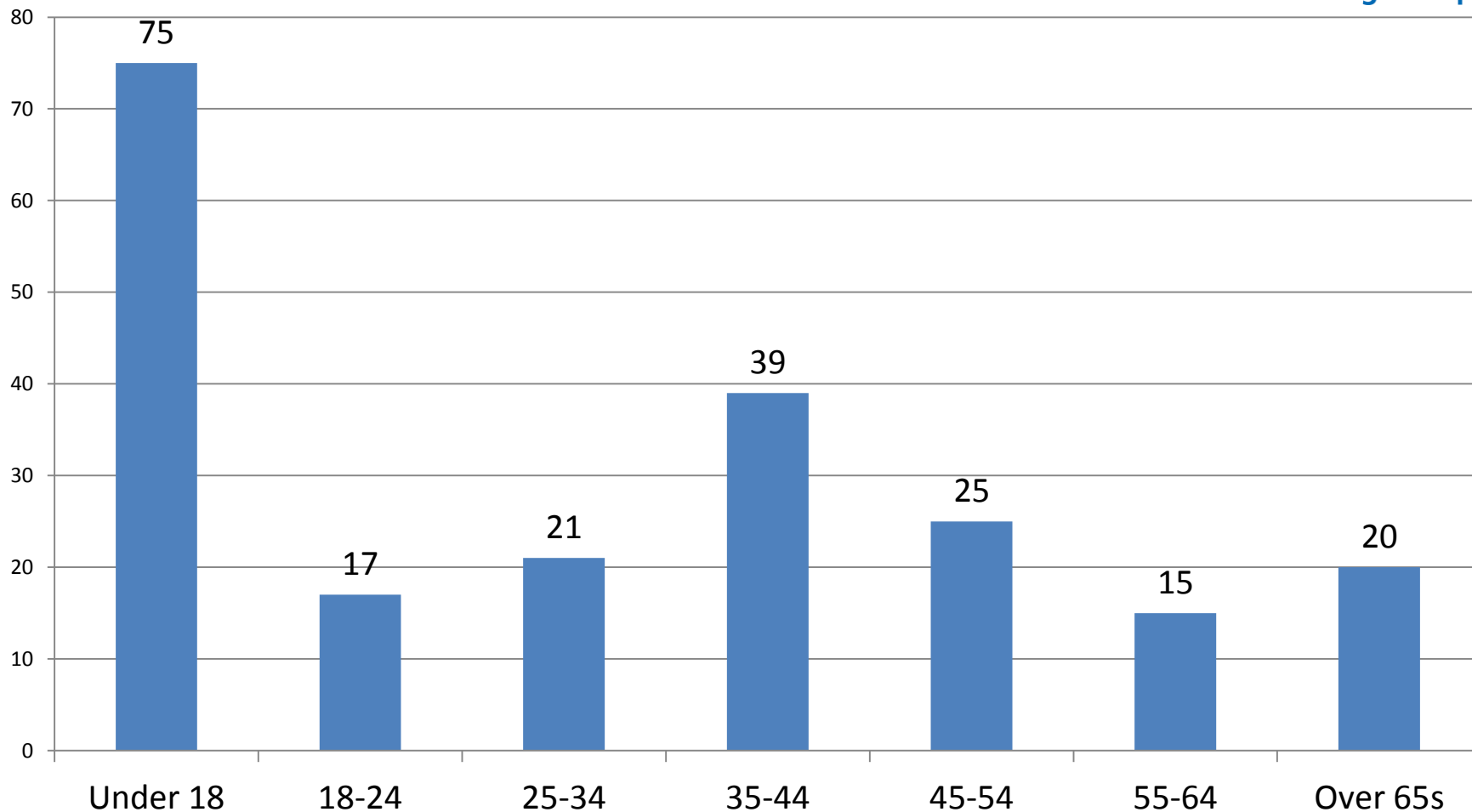

Demographics: characteristics

- Gender
 - Female (52%) Male (48%)
- Ethnicity
 - Asian/Asian British (87%)
- Sexuality – majority heterosexual or prefer not to say
- Religion – majority Islam (87%)
- Disability – 15%



Demographics: disability

- Physical – 11 (34%)
 - Sensory – 3 (3%)
 - Learning Disability – 6 (19%)
 - Mental Health – 7 (22%)
 - Long term condition – 14 (44%)
